





Marlon James. **The Book of Night Women**




Even at her birth, the slave women around Lilith (born into slavery on a Jamaican sugar plantation at the end of the 18th century) recognise a dark power to both revere and fear. The Night Women, as they call themselves, have long been plotting a slave revolt, and as Lilith comes of age and reveals the extent of her power, they see her as the key to their plans. But when she begins to understand

her own feelings, desires and identity, Lilith starts to push at the edges of what is imaginable for the life of a slave woman in Jamaica, and risks becoming the conspiracy's weak link.

Lilith's story overflows with high drama and heartbreak, and life on the plantation is rife with dangerous secrets, unspoken jealousies, inhuman violence, and very human emotion between slave and master, between slave and overseer, and among the slaves themselves.





caution wiser than she knows?





La's Orchestra Saves the World





The Americas, 1680s: Jacob is an Anglo-Dutch trader and adventurer, with a small holding in the harsh north. Despite his distaste for dealing in "flesh", he takes a small slave girl in part payment for a bad debt from a plantation owner in Catholic Maryland. This is Florens, "with the hands of a slave and the feet of a Portuguese lady". Florens looks for love, first from Lina, an older servant woman at her new

master's house, but later from a handsome blacksmith, an African, never enslaved.

There are other voices: Lina, whose tribe was decimated by smallpox; their mistress, Rebekka, a victim of religious intolerance back in England; Sorrow, a strange girl who's spent her early years at sea; and finally the devastating voice of Florens' mother.


A Mercy reveals what lies beneath the surface of slavery. But at its heart it is the ambivalent, disturbing story of a mother who casts off her daughter in order to save her, and of a daughter who may never exorcise that abandonment.

Road Rage (two novellas: *Duel & Throttle*)





Mark Slouka. The Visible World



Colm Tóibín. Mothers and Sons




Following on from **The Persimmon Tree**, Nick Duncan (now known as the Patriarch of the islands) is dealing with bereavement and disturbing flashbacks.

Henry Miller. **Tropic of Cancer**





Only a historic court ruling that changed American censorship standards, ushering in a new era of freedom and frankness in modern literature, permitted the publication of this first volume of Miller's famed mixture of memoir and fiction,



which chronicles with unapologetic gusto, the bawdy adventures of a young expatriate writer, his friends, and the characters they meet in Paris in the 1930s. **Tropic of Cancer** is now considered, as Norman Mailer said, "one of the ten or twenty great novels of our century."

The Great Poets: Oliver Wendell Holmes




Oliver Wendell Holmes (1809–1894) described it in his poem *A Metrical Essay*, and he himself had it in abundance: poetic sense. He could apply his gift to almost any subject – to love, nature, patriotic and religious themes, to a glass of wine, a punch bowl, a cherished college fraternity, even to a stethoscope. Rhyme and metre came easily to Holmes.

In a preface to his poems he may have modestly disclaimed some of his early work as too 'schoolboy-like', with 'questionable extravagances', but he was always immensely readable, humane and sensitive, and he became one of the most popular poets of his age. Included in this collection are his major poems, including *Old Ironsides* and *The Last Leaf*.

The Great Poets: William McGonagall




This Scottish poet has the unusual reputation as one of the worst poets in the English language. His 'masterpiece' is **The Tay Bridge Disaster**. McGonagall knew how to rhyme – just; but nothing else. He was a creator of verse that undermines its pretensions to gravitas with striking banality; poetry whose high ambitions are brought to earth through astounding lack of

rhythm or metre, or bathetic juxtapositions of high tragedy and absurd prosaism. He could take the most terrible and tragic event and turn it – seemingly unconsciously – into a parody of the epic form, making something the audience should feel awed by, simply awful.

Rupert Brooke. His Life and Poetry




Includes over 40 of Rupert Brooke's poems with this account of his brief life (he died aged 27).

Classic poems like **The Soldier**, **The Fish**, **The Old Vicarage**, **Grantchester** and **Dining-Room Tea** are combined with rare archive recordings of his close friends. Cathleen Nesbitt

reads the poem **Safety** and reminisces about the times she spent with him; Katherine Abercrombie, a member of his literary circle, remembers him in a 1956 recording, and his cousin, Winifred Kinsman, recalls him in a touching interview.

Matsuo Bashō, Kamo no Chōmei. Narrow Road to the Interior & Hōjōki



Japanese poetry is well-known for its clarity and concision, and *Narrow Road to the Interior* and *Hōjōki* are two of the best-loved, and most intensely Japanese, works of their kind; famous for their beautiful, delicate verse and subtle insight into the human condition. It has been said of *Narrow Road* that 'it was as if the very soul of Japan had itself written it'.

It takes the form of a travel diary, and traces the poet's journey from Edo (modern-day Tokyo) to the northern interior. *Hōjōki*, a much earlier work written by Chōmei, a Buddhist hermit, is essentially a meditation on the transience of the world. Read by the famous classical Japanese actor Togo Igawa, the full beauty of its ancient cadences and rhythms is drawn out.
